



The Town of Islip Youth Bureau and Youth Board know that **Kids Really Do Count!** Together they work with four non-for-profit agencies to provide services Townwide for youth under the age of 21. These agencies provide services utilizing various locations throughout the Town.

#### They are:

South Shore Community Organization Youth Enrichment Services Youth & Family Counseling Program



Each agency has a Community Board comprised of representatives from communities they serve. These Boards deterine the types of services that will be offered, based upon the needs of their community. These vital services include...



Counseling services for youth and their families are provided in strict confidence, by qualified counselors. In addition, all services are offered FREE of charge.



To coordinate this network of youth services, the Islip Town Board created the Youth Bureau in 1975, to organize and administer youth programs.

At the same time, the Islip Town Board created a townwide Youth Board. Membership on the Youth Board is reflective of the ethnic, racial, and geographic characteristics of the Town. One-third of its members must be under the age of twenty-one.

Youth are encouraged to participate in the planning of agency programs by joining Youth Councils and serving on Community Boards. Involvement in these programs is an excellent way for youth to learn about their community and themselves.
